



The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting dated December 23, 2020 has revised guidelines for obtaining license for providing Direct-To-Home (DTH) broadcasting service in India.

- a) MIB dated December 23, 2020 has revised guidelines for obtaining license for providing Direct-To-Home (DTH) broadcasting service in India.
- b) Public License for the DTH will be issued for a period of 20 years in place of present 10 years. Further the period of License may be renewed by 10 years at a time.
- c) The cap of 49% FDI in the existing DTH guidelines will be aligned with the extant Government (DPIIT's) policy on FDI as amended from time to time.
